(Treatment for weight loss and detoxification)

- Female: Late thirties
- Stressful occupation
- No history of direct exposure to environmental toxins
- Wt. 144.8 lbs.; Ht. 62 ¾ inches
- Normal BP in both arms; normal temperature
- Exercise: 1 to 2 times per week > aerobics


Leptin is synthesized by WAT

- Major regulator of body weight by suppressing appetite
- Elevated plasma levels correlate with the amount of body fat; obese individuals have high circulating leptin levels, indicating a resistance to its action
- Pro-inflammatory cytokine; increased during acute infection and inflammation; Increased by inflammatory mediators such as TNF- α , IL-6, and IL-1
